THE PARTNERSHIP:

- Promotes ecologically based, landscape-scale restoration and management of national forests within the Middle Truckee River watershed
- Coordinates with stakeholders and landowners to increase collaboration and efficiencies

GOALS:

1. Develop a 10 Year Forest Restoration and Fuels Reduction Strategy
2. Improve and restore forest health and resilience
3. Reduce the risk of high severity wildfire
4. Protect communities from wildfire impacts
5. Protect and secure water supplies and infrastructure
6. Identify and augment resources gaps to achieve implementation at an increased pace and scale

FAST FACTS:

- 265,000 acres covered in the partnership
- 62,000 acres require analysis and/or treatment
- 29,000 acres now in planning or implementation
- \$140M needed for the 62,000 acres

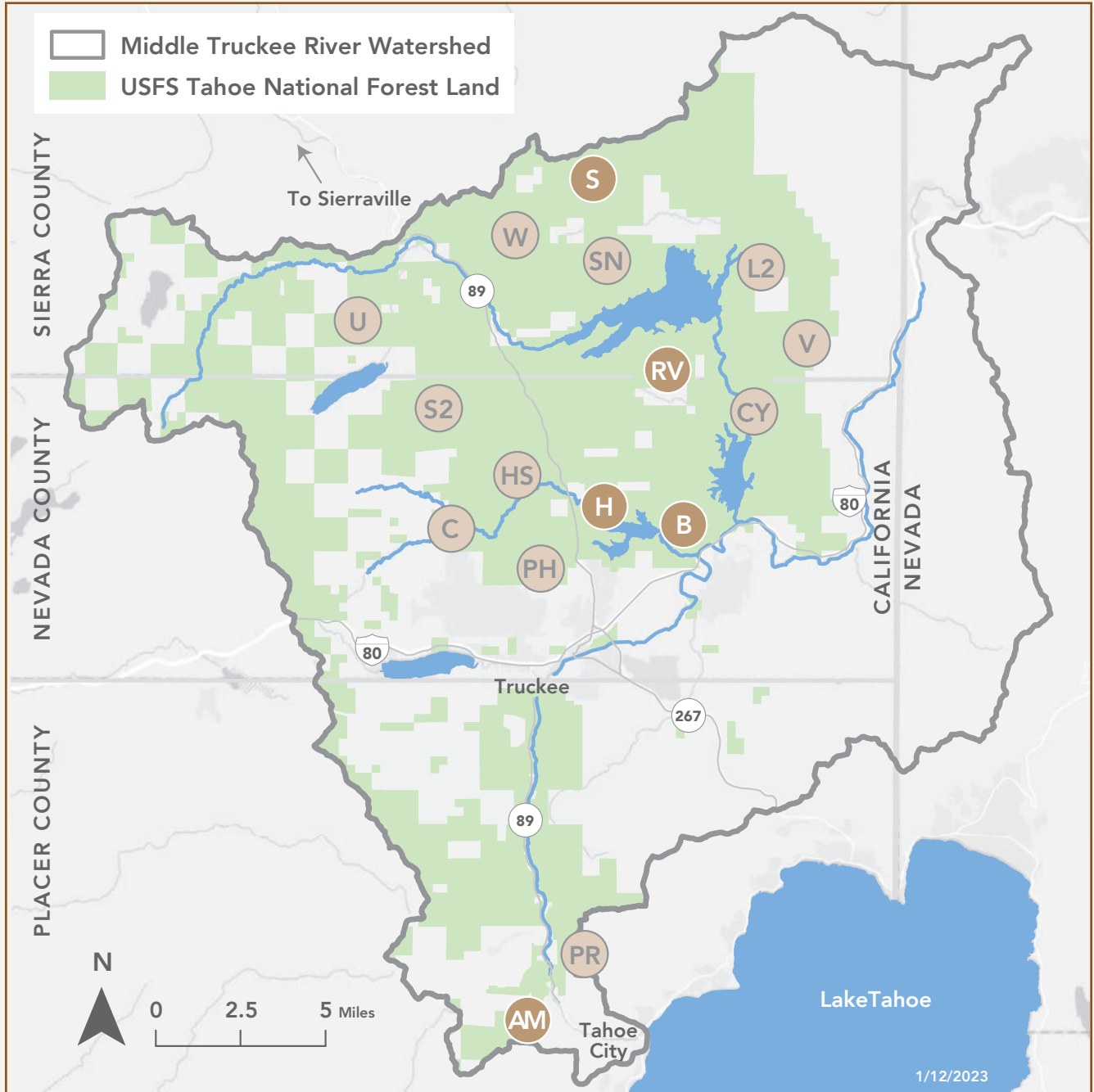

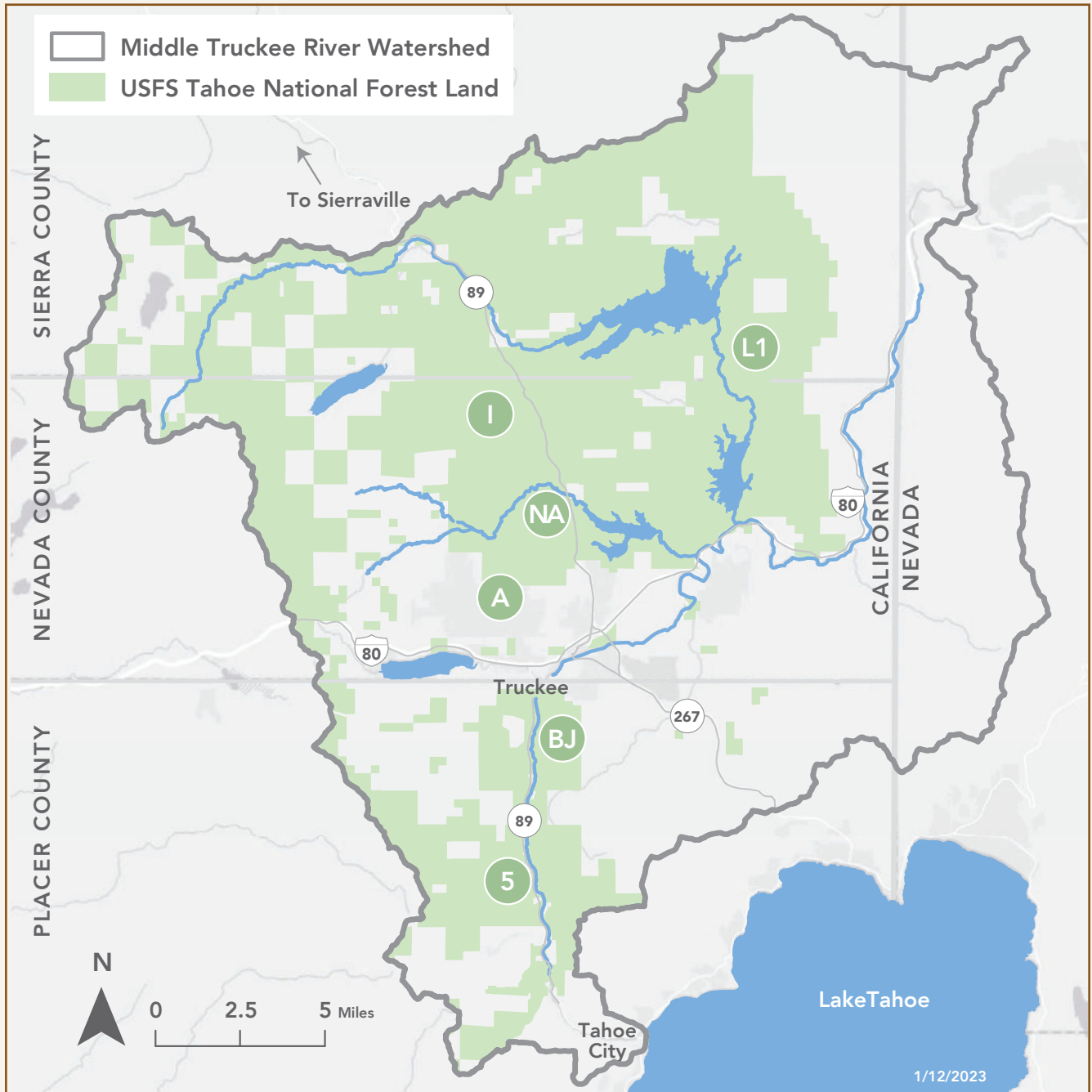
